Thank you for your Report of Investigation 2011-047. This letter and attachments will serve as our response.

At the time of employment, employees receive the current political activity policy, and a copy of ORC Section 124.57 together with an acknowledgement. These items are attached. This form is maintained at the location of employment.

Regarding taking action when management becomes aware of political activity, Policy HR-013, Standards of Conduct, designates the appointing authority as responsible for initiating the investigation. The Disciplinary Grid attached to this policy specifies engaging in political activity as prohibited by ORC 124.57 (see Section (N)(6)). We periodically review the requirements of this policy with the appointing authorities. We have determined that no action is required to address management's response to this employee's political activity.


Dear Mr. Meyer:
