Subject: Firewood Collection Area Procedures

Attached please find the official designation of Firewood Collection Areas for Scioto Trail State Park. This notice must be posted in accordance with rule 1501:41-3-01 of the Administrative Code and the designated area clearly marked.

In firewood collection areas, people may collect fallen or downed wood. This includes any wood such as twigs, branches or logs that has accumulated on the ground as a result of natural occurrences, or trees cut for area management purposes.

Conditions to note:

1. The designation shall be for a three month period or less. If a longer time is needed the area must be re-designated. Effective dates of this permit are March 18, 2014 through April 30, 2014.
2. The area must be clearly marked as a firewood collection area. In addition the designation must be posted in accordance with rule 1501:41-3-01 of the OAC.
3. No fee shall be charged for the collection and removal of wood in a firewood collection area.
4. No standing trees or branches still on the trees are permitted to be cut or collected.
5. Chain saws may be used in this Firewood Collection area.
6. Division employees are prohibited from participating in this program.
7. Firewood may be collected during daylight hours, Mondays through Thursdays.

Subject: Firewood Collection Area Procedures

Attached please find the official designation of Firewood Collection Areas for Tar Hollow State Park. This notice must be posted in accordance with rule 1501:41-3-01 of the Administrative Code and the designated area clearly marked.

In firewood collection areas, people may collect fallen or downed wood. This includes any wood such as twigs, branches or logs that has accumulated on the ground as a result of natural occurrences, or trees cut for area management purposes.

Conditions to note:

1. The designation shall be for a three month period or less. If a longer time is needed the area must be re-designated. Effective dates of this permit are March 18, 2014 through April 30, 2014.
2. The area must be clearly marked as a firewood collection area. In addition the designation must be posted in accordance with rule 1501:41-3-01 of the OAC.
3. No fee shall be charged for the collection and removal of wood in a firewood collection area.
4. No standing trees or branches still on the trees are permitted to be cut or collected.
5. Chain saws may be used in this Firewood Collection area.
6. Division employees are prohibited from participating in this program.
7. Firewood may be collected during daylight hours, Mondays through Thursdays.

FIREWOOD COLLECTION AREA DESIGNATION
