OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATION FINDS WRONGDOING AT OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY
WEXNER MEDICAL CENTER
Columbus, Ohio, January 14, 2014

The inspector general issued a report of investigation today finding wrongdoing involving meals and entertainment accepted by an employee at the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center and provided by an employee of a university vendor, Accu-Tech Corporation.

Acting on allegations provided by a confidential informant, the inspector general's investigation found Shawn Brown, a university medical center employee, wrongfully accepted \$4,900 in meals and entertainment provided by a telecommunications equipment supplier. The investigation revealed Matt Daugherty of Accu-Tech Corporation also took a wrongful course of action as a university vendor, by providing meals and entertainment to Brown.

Daugherty has since severed employment with Accu-Tech and was hired to work for his former client, the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center.

The report of investigation has been forwarded to the Ohio Ethics Commission, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney, and the Columbus City Attorney, for consideration.
