OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATES WRONGFUL ACTIONS BY OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION EMPLOYEE  
Columbus, Ohio, September 5, 2013

The inspector general has completed an investigation of an Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation employee found to be conducting a communications and utility marketing business during days and times when at work for the state of Ohio.

Acting on a complaint from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, the inspector general's investigation confirmed Kim Rogers, an employer services specialist in Dayton, was not only marketing to co-workers and premium-paying customers of the bureau, but attempting to recruit others to join the marketing firm. Rogers admitted using the state government's office equipment and email system in the effort.

The inspector general has provided the report of investigation to the Ohio Ethics Commission for consideration.
