OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL FINDS STATE MEDICAL BOARD CHIEF OF INVESTIGATIONS
MISUSED VEHICLE

Columbus, Ohio, May 23, 2013

The inspector general has issued a report of investigation today finding an employee at the State Medical Board of Ohio wrongfully used a state-assigned vehicle.

Douglas Edwards, chief of investigations for the State Medical Board of Ohio, was assigned a state-issued vehicle to carry out his duties as the agency's top investigator. However, the inspector general's investigation found Edwards was unable to account for more than 3,000 miles of state-vehicle use over a one-year period.

The review of Edward's actions was launched after the inspector general received an anonymous complaint. The report of investigation has been forwarded to the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney.
