OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATES IMPROPER MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS AT THE  
DAYTON CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION  
Columbus, Ohio, June 11, 2014

The inspector general issued a report of investigation today in review of a complaint received from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction, expressing concerns about management and expenditure of the industry and entertainment funds for the Dayton Correctional Institution.

Working together with the Ohio State Highway Patrol, the investigation found that a breakdown and erosion of management oversight permitted administrators to increasingly ignore fiscal policies and procedures. The business administrator at the Dayton Correctional Institution, David Ragland, has since retired.

The report of investigation will be provided to the Ohio Auditor of State, Ohio Office of Budget and Management, Ohio Department of Taxation, and U.S. Internal Revenue Service for consideration.
