OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL FINDS POLICY AND ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES AT OHIO
MANUFACTURED HOMES COMMISSION
Columbus, Ohio, January 7, 2015

The Ohio Inspector General has issued a report of investigation revealing a substantial lack of administrative management and oversight at the Ohio Manufactured Homes Commission.

The report identified wrongful actions involving travel and timekeeping records, slow payments to contract inspectors, and a set of agency policies that had not been revised for almost 10 years.

The inspector general has made a number of recommendations and asked the chairman of the Ohio Manufactured Homes Commission to respond within 60 days.
