OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATION FINDS WRONGDOING AT THE OHIO ADJUTANT GENERAL'S DEPARTMENT
Columbus, Ohio, August 4, 2015

The inspector general has issued a report of investigation today based on a complaint alleging an employee at the Ohio Adjutant General's Department was conducting activities related to a second job as a college instructor while at work for the state of Ohio.

The inspector general's investigation found the adjutant general's employee, James Sims, was wrongfully using government resources and equipment to pursue activities related to a position Sims held as an adjunct faculty member at Franklin University. Investigators also found evidence indicating Sims asked other departmental employees to assist with document assembly related to Sims' work at the college.

The inspector general has asked the adjutant general to consider a number of recommendations and respond within 60 days.
