OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL FINDS POLICY VIOLATIONS AT OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
Columbus, Ohio, June 30, 2015

The inspector general has issued a report of investigation which was initiated after receiving a complaint from a former fraud investigation employee of the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation. The complainant alleged several fraud investigation employees from the same division where the complainant once worked had submitted improper or falsified timekeeping and travel records.

The inspector general did not find reasonable cause to conclude the employees accused had engaged in wrongful actions as alleged in the complaint. However, outside the scope of the complaint, the investigation found several employees had failed to properly follow a policy requiring more detailed documentation involving commute and timekeeping records.
