OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL FINDS WRONGDOING AT THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE
Columbus, Ohio, November 18, 2011

The Ohio Inspector General has completed an investigation of the Ohio Department of Insurance and has found wrongdoing.

Acting on an anonymous complaint received in October 2010, the investigation found the Ohio Department of Insurance committed an act of wrongdoing or omission by violating the hiring controls outlined in a 2010 executive order issued by former Governor Ted Strickland. In another instance, an appearance of impropriety was created when the Department of Insurance provided significant pay raises for two employees.
