**Description of Incident:**

On the above mentioned date, this officer was in route back to the Dayton APA office with Sr. Officer Tim Jones after a day of home visits. This Officer observed the Scott Leach at the BP station on Gettysburg and Germantown. This officer had approximately a week ago spoke with the Montgomery County prosecutor regarding Mr. Leach. The prosecutor knew that this officer had supervised the offender for approximately a year and a half for the state of TN. The offenders parole was revoked by TN and the offender was to return to TN. The prosecutor advised this officer that Mr. Leach had active warrants thru Montgomery county for Felony charges. Additionally this officer received phone calls from local Dayton Officer's who were attempting to locate Mr. Leach for the active warrants.

When this officer observed fugitive Leach at the BP station. This officer advised Sr. Officer Jones that Leach had felony warrants for his arrest out of Montgomery County. This officer attempted to speak with Mr. Leach. At that time he took off running. Sr. Officer Jones then ordered him to stop at which time Mr. Leach failed to comply. Sr. Officer Jones then gave chase of the offender.

It should be noted that this officer supervised Mr. Leach for approximately a year and a half and had a good rapport with the him. This officer never had any usual incidents with him and he always followed the verbal orders of this officer. This officer did not believe at any time that Mr. Leach would attempt to run. It was the intent of this Officer to detain the offender until Dayton Officer's could respond as this officer was aware that he was a fugitive. However, Mr. Leach ran and ordered his girlfriend who was still in the vehical to "GO". She took off while the gas pump was still in the vehicle.

Once Officer Jones began to chase the Mr. Leach, Sr. Officer Jones told this officer to follow in the state car. Upon reentering the vehicle this officer attempted to contact DPD, at to no avail. This officer was able to reach Det. Mike Arricho and requested assistance from DPD. Mike Arricho used his radio and was able to contact street crews in order to assist.

A short time later this officer found Sr. Officer Jones and Mr. Leach on Alvin street. When this officer got to Sr. Officer Jones and Mr. Leach. Sr. Officer Jones was giving Mr. Leach verbal commands to show him his hands. Mr. Leach finally complied and Mr. Leach was handcuffed. A pat down for officer safety was conducted by Sr. Officer Jones and a large knife was recovered from his person.

This officer was informed that Mr. Leach had been pepper sprayed. Mr. Leach was decontaminated with water and told to stand in the wind. This officer spoke again with DPD and advised them that Mr. Leach had been apprehended on Alvin. A short time Officer's arrived and the fugitive was taken into custody for Felony warrants.

**Description of Incident:**

This officer and PO Langer observed Scot Leach at the BP on Gettysburg near the Dayton District Office. PO Langer had spoken to the Prosecutor office and had been advised the offender had an active warrant for FTA for a felony. Dayton officers had also called PO Langer attempting to find a location for the fugitive. These officer stopped and decided to detain the fugitive for the local police. The offender immediately ran and this officer gave pursuit and verbally ordered the fugitive to stop. This officer chased the offender to Alvin St. During the chase the fugitive ran into a tree and cut his forehead. The fugitive hide in a set of bushes and this officer pinned him down and ordered him to show his hands. After three sets of verbal commands this officer sprayed the fugitive with Fox OC. The fugitive was then handcuffed and a large knife was taken from the fugitives pocket near where his hand had been placed prior to being sprayed. PO Langer has already called DPD to the scene and those officers aided in the decontamination of the fugitive. The fugitive was then transported by DPD to the Montgomery County Jail with two active Felony warrants.

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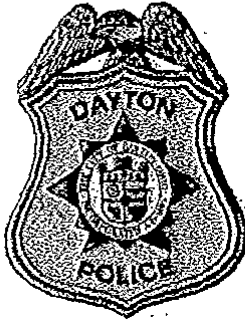

RAN FROM THEM. THEY WERE FINALLY ABLE TO CATCH THE INDIVIDUAL, LATER IDENTIFIED AS THE DEFENDANT, SCOTTY LEACH, AT 3951 NICHOLAS ROAD, JUST EAST OF S GETTYSBURG AVE, BUT IN THE PROCESS OF BEING ARRESTED HE WAS PEPPER SPRAYED BY PAROLE OFFICER TIMOTHY JONES. LEACH WAS FOUND TO HAVE 2 WARRANTS FOR HIS ARREST, ONE BEING A FELONY FOR PAROLE VIOLATION. WE TOOK POSSESSION OF LEACH AND NOTIFIED CREW 3306, SGT GILLIS OF THE CALL WE HAD, AND HE ARRIVED ON SCENE. WE TRANSPORTED LEACH TO GRANDVIEW HOSPITAL TO RINSE OUT HIS EYES FROM THE PEPPER SPRAY AND EVENTUALLY TRANSPORTED HIM TO THE MONTBOMERY COUNTY JAIL ON HIS WARRANTS. ONCE AT THE JAIL, CORRECTIONS OFFICER CP KIDWELL, CREW 773, TOOK LEACH INTO THE SHAKE DOWN ROOM. DURING A SEARCH OF HIS PERSON KIDWELL LOCATED A BLUE AND WHITE PACKAGE THAT WAS LABELED "SUBOXONE" INSIDE OF LEACH'S RIGHT SHOE. HE HANDED THIS PACKAGE TO OFFICER MILLS AND ADVISED THAT IT WAS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE. ALMOST IMMEDIATELY AFTER OFFICER MILLS TOOK THE SUBOXONE, LEACH CAME UP TO THE DOOR AND ASKED SEVERAL TIMES "YOUR NOT GOING TO CHARGE ME WITH THAT, ARE YOU?" "DON'T CHARGE ME WITH THAT." KIDWELL ADVISED THAT HE WOULD ALSO NEED TO DO A REPORT ON IT SINCE IT WAS TRANSPORTED INTO THE JAIL. A NEW BOOKING SLIP WAS COMPLETED WITH THE ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF POSSESSION OF DRUGS ON IT. OFFICER MILLS AND I THEN TOOK THE SUBOXONE, WHICH HAD 1 (ONE) 2 MG STRIP INSIDE OF IT, OUT OF THE 4 (8MG) THAT WAS IN IT ORIGINALLY, AND PLACED IT INTO THE PROPERTY ROOM. A LAB SHEET WAS ALSO COMPLETED AND THE SUSPECTED DRUGS WERE PROPERLY MARKED AND TAGGED IN AS EVIDENCE.
