OHIO INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATION RESULTS IN FEDERAL INDICTMENT OF FORMER OHIO DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES EMPLOYEE
Columbus, Ohio, June 17, 2016

As a result of an investigation conducted by the Ohio Inspector General, U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the U.S. Department of Labor, the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Ohio has obtained a federal grand jury indictment of a former employee of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and the chief executive officer of a local software development company.

The state employee and software company CEO conspired to sell to the state of West Virginia, a multi-million dollar software solution belonging to the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

Jatinder Singh, a former Ohio Department of Job and Family Services employee, and Anju Vallabhaneni, the CEO of United Software Group of Dublin, Ohio, were indicted by a federal grand jury for wire fraud, conspiracy, and destruction of records. The allegations against Singh and Vallabhaneni were outlined in a [U.S. Department of Justice news release](#) issued by Acting United States Attorney for the Southern District of Ohio Benjamin C. Glassman.

Ohio Inspector General Randall Meyer stated: "People who abuse the public trust should be given no quarter. We will continue to partner with the U.S. Attorney and the FBI in safeguarding Ohio in our fight against public corruption."

At the request of the U.S. Attorney, the Office of the Ohio Inspector General will issue a report of investigation at a later date. In consideration of the pending court action, all comments will be deferred until the report of investigation has been issued.
